Bundaberg Rowing Club Membership Fees.

Affiliation fees for the 2011 rowing season have been set by the Bundaberg Rowing Club. **All fees are to be paid to the office at Shalom College.** Cheques are to be made payable to Shalom College. The school will forward all fees due for Shalom Rowing to the Bundaberg Rowing Club

There is an insurance component for each of the Bundaberg Rowing Club membership fees. All rowers must have this cover prior to commencing the rowing programme.

Students will not be able to row unless they are financial members.

Membership Type

Bundaberg Rowing Club has various types of membership.

To row in the local interschool competition only (up until Head of the River May 2011) costs \$115.00

"Junior Competitive" membership costs \$250.00 and entitles the rower to use the Bundaberg Rowing Club facilities to the end of the calendar year i.e. 31.12.11

Shalom Rowing recommends rowers pay fees for local season only i.e. \$115.00

If a student pays for the full season i.e. \$250.00 and then elects not to row past the Head of the River, the Bundaberg Rowing Club may not refund the 'un-used' membership

Shalom Rowing will collect the additional membership fees in May if the rower elects to 'row on' until the end of the season or end of the year.

Shalom Rowing Fees.

A boat maintenance fee is charged for all rowers participating in the rowing programme. These fees go towards the cost of maintaining rowing boats, coaching tinnies and trailers. There is a two-tiered fee structure that takes into account rowers who row to the Head of the River only (\$30.00) and those rowing to the end of the year pay an additional \$20.00.
